Kenwood K-8 Center Upper Academy Uniform Policy

DRESS CODE - Board Rule 6Gx13-5C-1.031

Students are expected to come to school with proper attention having been given to personal cleanliness, grooming, and neatness of dress. Students whose personal attire or grooming distracts the attention of other students or teachers from their school work shall be required to make the necessary alterations to such attire or grooming before entering the classroom or be sent home by the principal to be properly prepared for school. Students who fail to meet the minimum acceptable standards of cleanliness and neatness as determined by the principal and as specified in this rule shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary measures including suspension.

Shirts	 "Polo" style shirts must be red or teal with the Kenwood crest. Tight-fitting or baggy shirts are NOT permitted. Undershirts (short-sleeve or long-sleeve) that are worn must be white, black or grey. Undershirts MUST be tucked in.
Pants	 Navy blue or khaki pants must be in an appropriate style. Pants must be worn appropriately at the waist. Tight-fitting or baggy pants are NOT permitted. Capri's, jeans, stretchy fabrics, shorts and sweatpants are NOT permitted.
Skirts	 Navy blue or khaki skirts must be in an appropriate style. Skirt length must be appropriate. Skorts are NOT permitted.
Jackets/Sweatshirts	Jackets/sweatshirts must be a plain, solid color. • Logos and hoodies are NOT permitted.
Shoes	 Closed shoes are mandatory. Sandals, crocs and slippers are NOT permitted. Cleats or specialized sporting shoes are NOT permitted. Shoes with wheels are NOT permitted.

HATS, COLORED HAIR, LARGE JEWELRY, MAKE-UP OR ANY OTHER ITEMS THAT THE SCHOOL DETERMINES TO BE A DISTRACTION WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.
